#### Monthly costs for a family in New Jersey (2 adults, 1 infant, 1 toddler)

The total number of New Jersey households that cannot afford basic needs continues to increase despite reports of overall improvement in employment and gains in median incomes. Many families continue to face challenges from low wages, depleted savings, and the increasing cost of basic household goods.
