Fight Hunger

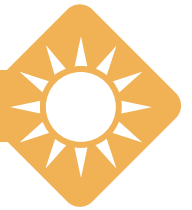
Create portable, nutritious lunches, breakfasts, or snack packs for distribution to local soup kitchens, shelters, or food pantries.
