Signature Projects



Act For ALICE Children (February – April)

Choose from several volunteer projects aimed at helping area children from ALICE families. Project options include in-person, virtual and for people of all ages.



Day of Action (June)

Join with other volunteers on or near June 21st (the longest day of the year) to make a difference in the community as part of this nationwide day of service.



Tools for School (July – August)

Help children from ALICE families and households in poverty start the school year off right by collecting new school supplies. Volunteers can also sort supplies for distribution.



Free Tax Preparation (October – April)

Become a trained IRS-certified volunteer and provide free tax preparation to ALICE families. Volunteers can also serve as greeters, translators, reviewers, intake specialists, and site coordinators.



Gifts of the Season (November – December)

Fulfill holiday gift wishes of area children, seniors, and adults with disabilities who are struggling to afford the basics. Host a holiday drive for needed items and/or sort and count donated gifts before they are distributed.

Year-Round Opportunities



Foodstock

Run a collection drive to provide food and other essentials for those struggling with food security. Collected items are distributed through area partner food banks and pantries.



Book Buddies

Record yourself reading a children's story and help promote academic success. Recordings will be used by partner child care centers and other nonprofits serving ALICE families.

Collect and sort personal care items including travel size toiletries, then create care packages for those who are at risk of or facing homelessness.
