- Check numbers with data sheet provided by researchers
- Edit reports to ensure the content adheres to our Style Guide and high standards of accuracy, clarity, and conciseness.
- Ensure equity-centered narrative and consistency in style in all reports and materials.





Perform additional production editing tasks as needed.

Requirements:

- Bachelor's degree in Journalism, English, Literature, or a related field (or equivalent experience)
- Strong proofreading and editing skills
- Detail-oriented, with an eye for data and numbers
- Ability to prioritize assignments and meet tight deadlines
- Two or more years of professional experience as an editor or writer
- Strong collaborator, with the ability to share and receive constructive feedback
- Experience using Microsoft tools (Word, Excel, SharePoint)
- (Desired) Experience with Adobe InDesign and InCopy
